



# Family Bible Quiz

One of the kids' favorite things to do over the years has been "Family Bible Quiz." We'd all gather in the living room and one by one give the kids a chance to answer Bible questions. If they know the answer we give a reward (a piece of candy, etc.). If they don't know it, we ask if anyone else does and if so, they get an extra reward. Then the child who couldn't get the answer gets another turn with another question. We'll do this for several rounds. It's a great motivator for the kids to pay attention to Bible story time or when they read their own Bibles. We try to give them age-appropriate questions, allowing even the 2-year-olds to answer questions. Here's a sample Bible quiz we've used.
